



## **Bursary Award Named in honour of Noah Daoust**

*This award is named in memory of Noah Daoust who lost his own battle with cancer on February 4<sup>th</sup> 2005. Noah was a young boy of 8 years old suffering from 4<sup>th</sup> stage Neuroblastoma, a rare form of cancer. Noah's family want to commemorate Noah by giving the opportunity to young people in their pursuit of education in the field of cancer.*

*The Northern Cancer Research Foundation and the Daoust Family offer this bursary to students registered at an Ontario University in a **Master's or Ph.D. program relevant to cancer research** and on placement in the Regional Cancer Program in Sudbury. Preference will be given to students who are researching Neuroblastoma or Pediatric cancers and who have completed secondary school in a northern Ontario community.*

### **Criteria:** Open to:

- Post-secondary students registered in a Master's or Ph.D. program relevant to cancer research at an Ontario University e.g. tumor biology, medical physics, epidemiology and supportive care.
- Post-secondary students on placement in the Regional Cancer Program in Sudbury
- Full-time and part-time students will be considered
- Student must be attending an Ontario University in September 2009.

**Amount:** The amount of this award will be a minimum of \$1,000 annually. At the discretion of the NCRF Executive Committee, Stephanie and Dan Daoust, or their designates, this award may be divided between two qualified candidates. A recipient may apply and qualify for a second award for up to two years of funding.

### **Conditions:**

- Concurrent to submitting an application for this award, the successful applicant must be supported by a Regional Cancer Program researcher as graduate student supervisor. It is expected that the researcher hold an academic appointment at the appropriate university or appropriate credentials in their respective fields.
- Disciplines eligible for consideration of a bursary are: tumor or cell biology, social work and psychology.
- The Foundation office will administer the funds for this award.
